Health and safety benefits (treatment costs) Averting Behavior / Defensive Expenditures; Value is inferred from costs and expenditures incurred in mitigating or avoiding damages. Health and safety benefits (eg, cost of an installed air filtration system suggests a minimum willingness-to-pay to avoid discomfort or illness from polluted air).
